ORDINANCE NO. 436

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DOS PALOS AMENDING TITLE 17 OF THE CITY OF DOS PALOS MUNICIPAL CODE TO ESTABLISH A SMOKE SHOP AS A CONDITIONAL USE WITHIN THE C-2 COMMERCIAL DISTRICT

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Title 17 of the Municipal Code governs zoning within the City (hereinafter the "Zoning Code"); and

WHEREAS, Chapter 08 of Zoning Code contains the definitions for zoning within the City; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 34 of Zoning Code contains the permitted and conditional uses for the C-2 Service Commercial District within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Code does not currently contain a definition for what are commonly known as "smoke shops," which are retailers for the sale of smoking and/or tobacco products, including, but not limited to, cigars, pipe tobacco, and smoking accessories, including tobacco paraphernalia, electric cigarettes, and vapor devices, for off-premises consumption; and

WHEREAS, because the Zoning Code does not currently contain a definition for "smoke shops," such shops are not listed as either a permitted use or a conditional use in any zone within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires through the passage of this Ordinance to amend the Zoning Code so as provide a definition for "smoke shops" in Chapter 08 and to establish a smoke shop as a conditional use within the C-2 Service Commercial District.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council for the City of Dos Palos hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS

The City Council has duly considered the full record before it, which may include but is not limited to such things as the staff report, testimony by staff and the public, and other materials and evidence submitted or provided to the City Council. Furthermore, the recitals set forth above are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance to Ordinance to amend the Zoning Code in part to provide a definition for "smoke shops," and to establish smoke shops as a conditional use within the C-2 Service Commercial District.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENTS TO MUNICIPAL CODE

Section 2080 of Chapter 08 of Title 17 of the Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

"17.08.2080 Smoke shops.

Smoke shops means a retainer whose main or secondary purpose is the sale of smoking and/or tobacco products, including, but not limited to, cigars, pipe tobacco, and smoking accessories, including tobacco paraphernalia, electric cigarettes, and vapor devices, for off-premises consumption at a retain establishment."

Based on the amendment to Section 17.08.2080, the definition of "Sorority," previously contained in Section 17.08.2080, is now contained in Section 17.08.2090.

Section 030 of Chapter 34 of Title 17 of the Municipal Code (Conditional uses) is hereby amended to add the following subsection as a conditional use:

"O. Smoke shops."

SECTION 4. VALIDITY OF ORDINANCE

If any article, section, sub-section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE

The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause a summary of this Ordinance to be published by one insertion in a newspaper of general circulation in the County at least five (5) days prior to adoption and again fifteen (15) days after its adoption. If a summary of the Ordinance is published, then the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of the full text of the proposed Ordinance to be posted in the office of the City Clerk at least five (5) days prior to the City Council meeting at which the Ordinance is adopted, and again after the meeting at which the Ordinance is adopted. The summary shall be approved by the City Attorney.

The City of Dos Palos has reviewed the Preliminary Data presented by Syserco Energy Solutions, Inc. ("SES"), that details an opportunity for the Design Build Energy Project to reduce ongoing Operational Costs and increase Revenue without the need for any Capital outlay. The City of Dos Palos requests that SES proceed with an Investment Grade Audit ("IGA"), Final Engineering and Project Development of the City's Energy Conservation and Renewable Energy Program which will reduce operating costs and upgrade aging infrastructure.

The IGA will focus on the following systems: Wastewater Treatment Plant Energy Efficiency Measures - API Metering, Lighting, Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC), Building Automation and Controls, Building Envelope, IT Equipment, Appliances, Building Plug-Loads, EV Car Charging Stations, Plumbing and Solar PV + Storage. Other systems may be discovered in the course of the IGA.

The purpose of the IGA is to determine the feasibility of entering into an Energy Services Agreement (Agreement) utilizing CA GC 4217.

The City of Dos Palos intends to enter into an Energy Services Agreement ("Agreement") with SES if the following Project Criteria is met:

1. Budget Impact:

Project must not impact on existing capital budget.

Capital Outlay by the City of Dos Palos shall not be required

unless desired by the City.

2. Annual Savings:

Must meet annual Project Costs, at minimum.

3. Energy Savings: 100% of energy savings goes directly to the City of Dos Palos.

Savings shall not be shared with SES or others.

4. Financing: City Hall has the opportunity to qualify for 3rd Party

Financing or 3rd Party Ownership for the ECMs and/or Energy

Generation measures.

5. Financing Term: Shall not exceed the useful life of the proposed upgrades.

6. Rebate/Grant Application: Program shall include management of all grants and rebates, if

available.

7. Procurement Method: Procurement shall meet provisions of California Government

Code 4217.

The City of Dos Palos agrees to work exclusively with SES through the duration of the IGA and Project Development effort.

The City of Dos Palos intends to enter into an Energy Services Agreement with SES within 45 days following the delivery of a final Energy Services Proposal that will result from the Investment Grade Audit (IGA), Final Engineering and Project Development that SES will perform. This duration may be modified by mutual agreement.

All costs associated with Investment Grade Audit (IGA), Final Engineering and Project Development performed by SES shall be incorporated into the final Lump Sum Fixed Price of the Agreement.

In the event SES cannot meet these Project Parameters, there will be no charge to the City of Dos Palos for engineering, pre-construction activities, project development or estimating costs incurred by SES for the IGA.

In the event SES meets the Project Parameters above and The City of Dos Palos does not enter into the Agreement with SES within forty-five (45) days of submittal of the IGA, then the City shall pay SES a Break-Fee in the amount of:

Sixty-Eight Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$68,500.00).
